- A passion for teaching and learning in the classical tradition, using the Socratic method and primary sources.
- A proficiency in mathematics and the ability to teach mathematics at all high school levels, including Calculus.

- A willingness to collaborate with other teachers and staff in a professional and collegial manner.
- A flexibility and adaptability to the needs and challenges of a growing school.

The responsibilities of the faculty member will include:

- Teaching four or five math or science courses, such as Algebra, Euclid, Algebra II, Trigonometry, Precalculus, Calculus, Earth Science and Astronomy, Biology, Chemistry, and Physics, depending on the school's needs and the teacher's qualifications.
- Preparing and delivering engaging and effective lessons that align with the school's curriculum and standards.
- Assessing and grading students' work and providing constructive feedback.
- Communicating with parents, students, and administrators about student progress and concerns.
- Participating in faculty meetings, professional development, and school events.
- Supporting the school's culture of faith, virtue, and joy.
